

# UPLOADING ARTICLES ONLINE

Many websites for sharing scholarly articles are requesting for users to upload their publications online. The sites use the color coded system below to explain if uploading is allowed by the journal in which users have been published. The definitions for each color can vary between journals, so to figure out exactly what you as an author are allowed to do with your article without having to find your publishing contract, go to [Sherpa.ac.uk](http://Sherpa.ac.uk).

**Green means you can archive pre-print and post-print or publisher's version/PDF.**

**Blue means you can archive post-print (final draft post-refereeing) or publisher's version/PDF.**

**Yellow means you can archive pre-print (pre-refereeing).**

**White means archiving is not formally supported.**



## Publisher copyright policies & self-archiving

*Use this site to find a summary of permissions that are normally given as part of each publisher's copyright transfer agreement.*

Once there, just enter the name of the journal that published your paper in the Sherpa/Romeo search bar.

It will designate a color to that journal and explain exactly what you are allowed to do with your paper. Including whether or not you can upload it to sites like ResearchGate.
